# User manual

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#### 1. Important Safety Information

Unplug the TV from the wall outlet before cleaning. Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosol cleaners. Use a soft and slightly damp cloth for cleaning.

#### 5. Water and Moisture

Do not use this TV near water, for example, near a bathtub, wash bowl, kitchen sink, or laundry tub, in a wet basement, or near a swimming pool.

#### 6. Accessories Carts and Stands

#### 12. Lightning


For added protection for the TV during a lightning storm, or when it is left unattended and unused for long periods of time, unplug it from the wall outlet and disconnect the antenna or cable system. This will prevent damage to the TV from lightning and power-line surges.

#### 13. Outdoor Antenna Grounding

If an outside antenna or cable system is connected to the TV be sure the antenna or cable system is grounded so as to provide some protection against voltage surges and built up static charges. Article 810 of the National Electrical Code (U.S.A.), ANSI / NFPA 70 provides information with regard to proper grounding of the mast and supporting structure, grounding of the lead-in wire to an antenna discharge unit, size of grounding conductors, location of antenna-discharge unit, connect on to grounding electrodes, and require-

ments for the grounding electrode.

#### 14. Power Lines

An outside antenna system should not be located in the vicinity of overhead power lines or other electric light or power circuits, or where it can fall on to power lines or circuits. When installing an outside antenna system, extreme care should be taken to keep from touching such power lines or circuits as contact with them might be fatal.

#### 15. Overloading

Do not overload wall outlets and extension cords as this can result in a risk of fire or electric shock.

#### **Important Safety Information**

16. Object and Liquid Entry

Never push objects of any kind into this TV through openings as they may touch dangerous voltage points or short-out parts that could result in a fire or electric shock. Never spill liquid of any kind on or inside the TV.

# Installing the Stand



1. Place the TV set on soft cloth or cushion with face down. Place the base in position as shown. (see Figure 1).

2. Fix the bracket with stand to the bottom of the TV with the four screws (see Figure 2)


3. Stand the TV up. (see Figure 3)

# **Disconnecting the Stand**

1. Lay the TV flat on a table with the LED screen face down. To prevent the TV from being scratched, put a piece of soft cloth on the table on which the screen will be set. (see Figure 1)


2. Then remove 4 screws of the stand as show. (see Figure 2)



We strongly recommend that you connect the antenna/cable input using a 75-ohm coaxial cable (not supplied) to ensure the best picture quality.



# 6. Using the Remote Control

#### **Inserting Remote Control Batteries**

- 1. Remove the battery cover by pulling then lifting the knob on the cover.
- 2. Insert the batteries, corresponding to the (+) and (-) markings on the battery compartment.
- 3. Reattach the battery cover.

#### **Operating the Remote Control**


1 .Aim Remote Control directly at the Remote Control Sensor on the left down corner of the TV set.

# Turning the TV On and Off

Press the POWER button on the remote control. You can also use the Power button on the side of the panel.

\*If there is no input signal within 15 minutes, TV will be turned off automatically.





#### Selecting the Input Source

To select the TV or other external input sources connected to the TV.

1. Press the SOURCE button on the remote control.

2. Press  $\blacktriangle$  or  $\lor$  to select the required input source between DTV,ATV, AV,YPBPR,HDMI or VGA.

3. To confirm the selection, press OK button to enter.

#### Install TV Channels Automatically



# 8. Channel setting







#### Precautions when using a USB device

- MTP (Media Transfer Protocol) is not supported.
- Max HDD capacity:500G.

• When moving to a photo, loading may take a few seconds. At this point, the loading icon will appear at the screen.


- If USB card reader is connected, its volume may not be detected.


# 14. Network Setting

2. To connect to the cable router, connected to the Internet through the LAN port on the wall.






#### Wireless network connection

1) In TV status, press the [Exit] key, a tip box appears on the screen (as the picture as below), now press the [OK] key, Then the screen get into the main menu.


2) In TV channel, press the right key, then you can enter launcher.



# 14. Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Solution
No power	<ul> <li>Make sure the power cord is properly connected to the LED TV AC power socket.</li> <li>Make sure the AC power cord is properly connected to the wall outlet.</li> <li>Make sure the DC power button is ON (Blue LED).</li> <li>Plug another electrical device (like a radio) to the power outlet to verify that the outlet is supplying the proper voltage.</li> </ul>
No picture	<ul> <li>The TV station may be experiencing problems. Try another channel.</li> <li>The Cable TV signal may be scrambled or encoded. Please contact your local cable operator.</li> <li>Make sure that connection to other components are correct referring to the user guide.</li> <li>Make sure that setup has been done correctly after connections.</li> <li>Make sure the correct input is selected and the input signal is compatible.</li> </ul>
Strange color, light color, or color misalignment	<ul> <li>Ensure that the video cable is securely connected.</li> <li>The picture may appear dim in a brightly lit room.</li> <li>Adjust brightness, contrast, saturation (color), and tint referring to the user guide.</li> <li>Check the input signal setting.</li> </ul>
No sound	<ul> <li>Check your audio connections are properly connected referring to the user guide.</li> <li>The MUTE button may have been pressed, try pressing this button again.</li> <li>Check your audio settings, your TV audio may be set to minimum.</li> <li>Press the Volume + (Up) button on the remote control.</li> </ul>
Remote control unit does not operate	<ul> <li>Make sure the directions of batteries are inserted correctly referring to the user guide.</li> <li>Batteries could be weak or dead. Replace with new batteries.</li> <li>Is a fluorescent light illuminated near the remote control sensor?</li> <li>The path of the remote control beam may be blocked. Make sure the path is clear and that the remote control is aimed at the remote control sensor on the TV.</li> <li>Press the POWER button on the remote control to see if you can turn on the TV.</li> <li>Press MENU button on the remote control to see if there is a MENU shown on the screen.</li> <li>Press only one button at a time and it is the correct one for the operation you want to perform.</li> </ul>

Problem	Possible Solution
Unit cannot be operated	<ul> <li>External influences such as lightning or static electricity may cause improper operation. In this case, operate the unit after first turning on the power of the LED TV and the AVC</li> <li>System, or unplug the AC cord for 1 to 2 minutes, then replug again.</li> </ul>
Power is cut off suddenly	<ul> <li>Is the sleep timer set in advance?</li> <li>Is there no signal in PC mode or HDMI mode?</li> <li>The internal temperature of the unit has increased. Remove any objects blocking the vent or clean as necessary.</li> </ul>
No CATV reception (or no reception above CH13)	<ul> <li>Is the AIR/CABLE option set correctly? Please set the AIR/CABLE option to CABLE referring to the user guide.</li> <li>CATV is connected improperly or not connected; please check all the CATV connections.</li> <li>The cable TV service is interrupted; please contact your cable operator.</li> </ul>
Picture is cut off/with sidebar screen	<ul> <li>Is the image positioned correctly?</li> <li>Are screen mode adjustments such as picture size set correctly?</li> <li>Press WIDE button repeatedly on the remote control to see if you can get the picture you prefer.</li> </ul>
